



## 1. Contract creation and payment of camp fees

1.1 A binding contract of participation to the GoalieSam Camp is created when the participant pays the registration payment (per participant), on the date designated by GoalieSam Hockey Schools.

2. Participant can cancel his/her participation to the camp as follows:

2.1. a) By cancelling the participation to GoalieSam Hockey Schools, no later than 60 ( 2 months) days before the beginning of the camp.

b) If participation is cancelled later than 60 days before the beginning of the camp, GoalieSam Hockey Schools retains the right to collect the entire 100% fee for camp participation. In case of sickness or injury there must be an official medical document presented and with that document GoalieSam Hockey Schools can refund a maximum of 50% of the total camp fee. However, if the injury happens no later than 60 days to the start of the camp, and the participant has paid the invoice already, GoalieSam refunds the total 100% camp payment, excluding registration fee of 150€, back.

2.2 If participation is not cancelled and the participant does not arrive at the camp at the designated date and time to begin the camp, or the participant can not arrive at the camp because he/she does not have access to appropriate travel documents, such as a current passport, personal identification, or travel tickets, GoalieSam Hockey Schools has the right to invoice the full camp fee from the participant and/ or retains the right to collect the entire 100% fee for camp participation.

3. GoalieSam Hockey Schools as the organizer of the hockey schools

3.1. GoalieSam Hockey Schools is responsible for organizing the camp and ice hockey training according to the training programs and schedules put forth. This responsibility includes all sports venues. GoalieSam Hockey Schools is not responsible for insuring the hockey school participants. Regarding activities on ice, other training occasions, or whenever activities are directed or supervised by the coaches of the hockey school the insurance terms and conditions of the student's ice hockey license and/or private insurance agreement apply.

3.2 GoalieSam Hockey Schools rents the accommodation facility from the Skien Fritidspark and they are responsible of preparing and delivering all the meals during the event. Including all the special diets (allergies), info must have been sent to GoalieSam Hockey Schools together with the camp application. The accommodation facility ( Skien Fritidspark) is also responsible of the safety and practicality of the facility we stay during the camp. Each participant is responsible for any damages caused oneself in the facility.

3.3 All students that attend to GoalieSam Hockey Schools camps shall also take responsibility of their own safety and well being. No rollerblading without a helmet and approval from the participants parents for it for the duration of the camp. Common sence and individual responsibility in every day action is encouraged. No students are allowed to leave or go alone from the accommodation facility or/ and ice hall.

4.0 Force Majeure:essentially frees both parties from liability or obligation when an extraordinary event or circumstance beyond the control of the parties, such as a war,strike,riot, crime, or an event described by the legal term " *act of God*» (such as

hurricane, flooding, earthquake, volcanic eruption, etc.), prevents one or both parties from fulfilling their obligations under the contract. In practise, when or if such act happens and breaks the ice surface or other essential facilities to run the program, organizer will provide a alternative program under the circumstances, but will not refund any costs caused by the force majeure.
